By Road:

The Woodhall Spa Hotel is located on The Broadway, the village's main street, 300 metres from the roundabout.

From the South:

Take the A153 from Sleaford towards Horncastle. At Tattershall turn left on the B1192. In Woodhall Spa, turn right at the roundabout onto The Broadway.

From Lincoln and the North:

Take the A15 south from Lincoln. turn left onto the B1202 to Metheringham, then the B1189 to Martin and B1191 to Woodhall Spa. Go straight ahead at the roundabout onto The Broadway.

History and Character

A Different Age

The Woodhall Spa Hotel is located in the heart of this picturesque Lincolnshire golfing village. Previously known as The Eagle Lodge Hotel, it was acquired in 2005 by Hoby Hotels and underwent a total transformation in early 2006 to meet the needs of the 21st century visitor.

The Woodhall Spa Hotel is the oldest surviving hotel in the village. The original building, Eagle House, was built in the Arts and Crafts style during the early 1870's. In 1882 it was converted into a hotel called The Eagle Lodge Hotel. The hotel was extended into the current purpose-built hotel in 1889 and the outside of the hotel has remained virtually unchanged ever since. Although built for a different age, the hotel has now undergone a complete transformation - to ensure a comfortable and enjoyable stay.

Contemporary Rooms

Our main staircase with its "Arts and Craft" picture window invites you up to your room. Each bedroom has been totally refurbished in a soothing contemporary style. As you would expect with a hotel that dates back over 125 years, even though all the rooms are fitted out to the same standard, no two rooms are the same! Light oak furniture, leather chairs, 42" plasma high definition TVs, broadband, Wi-Fi, soft duvets, plump pillows and complimentary tea and coffee facilities - everything that you can want for a comfortable stay.

Many rooms have "zip and link" beds which allows us to style them as either a king-size, double or alternatively as a twin room. You'll have plenty of room to spread out, but do remember to tell us how you would like your room styling!

All of our bedrooms have ensuite bathrooms, which have been tastefully renovated with white bathroom suites with thermostatically controlled showers and, where possible, bidets.

Our double rooms feature a "normal size" double bed and are great for a couple and an indulgence for just one person. We have only three single rooms, two of which have 4ft wide beds. They have everything that the doubles and King Size have, including the 42" plasma HD TVs. Enjoy. Last but not least we have one very spacious four poster room which overlooks the gardens to the side of the hotel. Definitely a room to make the occasion special.

We also have two ground floor bedrooms, one of which has been equipped to be accessible for guests with disabilities. This twin room has a walk-in shower for easier access, as well as other disabled friendly features. For those guests who are planning to enjoy a round of golf at The National Golf Centre, we also have a battery charging room and secure golf bag store.
